CONGRATULATIONS on qualifying to represent your home track at the **2008 SUMMIT RACING SERIES FINALS** at **Bandimere Speedway** in **Morrison, Colorado, September 12-14, 2008.**

NHRA MEMBERSHIP & COMPETITION NUMBER INFO

NHRA MEMBERSHIP IS REQUIRED AT ALL NHRA SANCTIONED EVENTS You must be an NHRA member to run at the E.T. Finals. If you are going to participate in this year's E.T. Finals and you're not a member, you may pay for your membership when you are teched at your home track. Membership for one year is \$64.00. The benefits for being a member are 48 issues of the National Dragster, NHRA decal and \$485,000 worth of catastrophic insurance if you are injured at an NHRA sanctioned event. **APPLICATION FOR NHRA MEMBERSHIP AT THE EVENT WILL RESULT IN A \$10 SURCHARGE. PLEASE COME FULLY PREPARED.**

NHRA E.T. PERMANENT NUMBERS ARE MANDATORY TO RUN AT THE E.T. FINALS – NHRA permanent numbers must be painted or decaled on your vehicle in a contrasting color to the vehicle's background color, or light color on windows. Check your NHRA Rule Book for location and size. All PRO BIKE ET contestants must have number plates and dial-in plates on both sides of their bike. You must have an NHRA Competition number or License to run at the E.T. Finals. You may apply for your competition number when you are teched at your home track. **APPLICATION FOR NHRA NUMBER AT THE EVENT WILL RESULT IN A \$10 SURCHARGE. PLEASE COME FULLY PREPARED.**

NHRA COMPETITION DRIVERS/RIDERS LICENSE is required whenever you run quicker than 9.99 in the quarter mile (4.50 to 6.39 1/8 mile), no matter what kind of car or motorcycle you drive/ride. For license information, contact the Division Office at (816) 795-8055 or your local track manager. If you need to apply for NHRA license, you should submit your physical, application and test runs, along with appropriate fees, to the division office prior to the event. **APPLICATION FOR NHRA COMPETITION LICENSE AT THE EVENT WILL RESULT IN A \$10 SURCHARGE. PLEASE COME FULLY PREPARED.**

YOU MUST BE AT LEAST 16 YEARS OF AGE TO RACE ANY VEHICLE IN NHRA DRAG RACING (Junior Dragsters are the exception) and have a valid State Drivers License. If you are 17 and under, you must have WAIVER signed and notarized by **BOTH** your parents before any NHRA Member Track can let you race. Please have **BOTH** parents sign the waiver in the presence of a track official or it must be notarized prior to competition in the E.T. Finals. You will present this form at registration. If you need one of these forms prior to attending the E.T. Finals, contact your local Track or call the Division Office at (816) 795-8055.

YOU MUST BE AT LEAST 18 YEARS OF AGE TO RACE ANY VEHICLE AT ANY NHRA NATIONAL EVENT. At the start of the 2008 season all national event participants **MUST BE AT LEAST 18 YEARS OF AGE.** Any Champions of the Division Finals, and serving as division representatives at the NHRA Finals in Pomona, CA **MUST BE AT LEAST 18 YEARS OF AGE.**

SCHEDULE & GENERAL INFO

THERE WILL BE NO PARKING ON WEDNESDAY – Parking starts on Thursday, September 11th at 12:00 p.m. Registration from 2:00 p.m. until 6:00 p.m.

SCHEDULE FRIDAY–September 12th – Gates open 7:00 a.m. – Registration from 8:00 a.m. until 6:00 p.m. Time trials will start at 9:00 a.m. There will be a gamblers race if time permits.

SCHEDULE SATURDAY–September 13th – Registration from 8:00 am until 6:00 p.m. Time trials will start at 9:00 am. There will be a gambler's race if time permits. **TEAM PICTURES** will be taken on Saturday.

RACE OF CHAMPIONS–Will run on Saturday, September 13th. For a track to participate in the Race of Champions, they must have at least 5 participants at the ET Finals.

COOK OUT SATURDAY – September 13th – Cookout to begin at approximately 6:30 p.m. Each racer should bring a covered dish to share.

SCHEDULE SUNDAY – September 14th – Eliminations at 8:00 a.m. **GOOD LUCK!**

TECHNICAL INSPECTION – Tech will take place at your home track prior to the event. However, every racer must be prepared to be re-teched if asked. All participants must have proof of current NHRA membership and competition number with them at the event. Be sure that you have your track designation letter, i.e. BS, KC, TS, etc., along with your NHRA number on your car, visible to the tower. Each competitor will be responsible for turning in their tech cards to the registration trailer to receive their run cards.

RUN CARDS – You must present your completed and signed tech card along with your entry ticket to the NHRA registration trailer to get your run card.

TIME TRIALS – All eliminator categories will be run in sessions. Each participant will only be allowed one time trial per session. Run Cards will be used for all time trials. Listen to the PA for lane assignments and times.

E.T. BREAKS AND CLASSES – The E.T. breaks and classes to be used at the 2008 SUMMIT RACING SERIES FINALS at Bandimere's elevation will be as follows:
